SEASONAL TOURING PITCHES RULES

The Touring Site will be open from 1st March 2026 to 30th November 2026

A £100 deposit is payable on return of the enclosed completed booking form, followed by an additional £250 by the 1st of December, with full payment by the 1st March. Please note no refunds are given for any reason. We advise that your awnings are taken down when you are not occupying your caravan, Dyffryn Seaside Estate do not accept any liability for loss or damage caused to your caravan or neighbouring caravans. We also request that no permanent fences are erected on the touring site. Wind breakers can be put up, but only whilst using your caravan. At the end of the season, we also require that everything apart from a single shed or storage box is taken home with you. Including sandbags, garden furniture, fencing etc. Anything left behind will be disposed of.

- 1. No music or excessive noise permitted between the hours of 11pm and 8am the following morning and not at any time to create any noise that may be a disturbance to any other occupiers within the park. Campers must at all times conduct themselves with due regard to others.**
2. Adults or children must not dig holes on site.
3. Any person found damaging Estate property or being the cause of a disturbance at any time will be told to leave the site immediately.
4. Dogs are allowed on the camping field, in all cases dogs must not be allowed to foul the camping site, they must be exercised away from the site and kept on a lead at all times.
5. Refuse must be left at the dispersal points on the camping field and if it is necessary to use stones or bricks campers are requested to return them to their former surroundings.
6. Any person found giving water, barrier cards, or letting people through the barrier or into the toilets showers etc that are not staying with you or visiting you will have their barrier cards blocked, and will be asked to leave the park.
7. No firearms, fireworks or sky lanterns are allowed on the camping field or adjoining sand hills.
8. No one must use the hand basins other than for personal use, there are washing up facilities provided at the end of each toilet block. A Laundrette is located opposite the reception for your clothes etc.
9. Children under the age of 16 are not permitted to camp on their own, they must be accompanied by an adult.
10. Vehicles must not be taken across the sand hills or on the beach.
11. No camping in the sand hills or adjoining car park.
12. No open fires, proprietary BBQ's may be used with care, disposable BBQ's are to be disposed of in the correct manner. (As instructed on the bin stands)
13. Only 1 touring caravan/motorhome and awning permitted on each touring hook up pitch (no Gazebo's or tents) all awnings and caravans/motorhomes must be on the hard standing plots and not on the grassed area.
14. Only 2 cars to be parked by each caravan, Jet Ski's & Boats must be parked on the Car Park.
15. A 5mph speed limit is enforced on the Estate.
16. **Children must be supervised at all times**, especially when they are riding their bikes.
17. **Electric Scooters, Segways, Quads etc are not allowed on site.**
18. Whilst the Estate is private property it is still an offence to "Drink & Drive or Drug Drive", the Police will be called to anyone suspected of driving whilst under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
